

KTIMA BRINTZIKI, TINAKTOROGOS 2015


WINE FOR THE WORLD

Ktima Brintziki is a producer of indigenous, rare varieties and is Greece's first *green* winery. Located in the Iliian region of the Peloponnese near the sacred town of Ancient Olympia, the family-owned property is certified organic and completely carbon-neutral through the use of renewable solar and geothermal energy. They grow indigenous varieties - some, like the Tinaktorgos, old enough to be referenced by Homer - and use natural yeast for most of their wines.

This wine is made from 100% Asproudes 100% grapes. It has medium, balanced acidity and a rich, delicate finish. This wine pairs well with poultry, salads and white cheese. Only 450 cases made.
