Cave Geisse is a boutique, internationally acclaimed producer of fine sparkling wine. And it's from Brazil. Made with extraordinary technical rigor from one of Chile's best winemakers in the Southern-most region of Brazil, Rio Grande do Sul, this traditional champenoise wine is made from 70% Chardonnay and 30% Pinot Noir micro-terroir grapes. It is full-bodied with hints of honey, dried apricots, balanced acidity, and a hint of minerality that stems from the Juro-Crustacean volcanic soil. Try it with sushi, creamy pastas, or if you're feeling fancy, Magret de Canard!

VARIETALS: 70% Chardonnay, 30% Pinot Noir
