

KTIMA BRINTZIKI, AUGOUSTIATIS 2012


WINE FOR THE WORLD

Ktima Brintziki is a producer of indigenous, rare varieties and is Greece's first green winery. Located in the Ilian region of the Peloponnese near the sacred town of Ancient Olympia, the family-owned property is certified organic and completely carbon-neutral through the use of renewable solar and geothermal energy. They grow indigenous varieties and use natural yeast for most of their wines.

This wine is made from 100% Augoustiatis grapes, a local variety found only in the Western region of the Peloponnese. This is a medium-bodied wine with balanced acidity, very round mature tannins and a soft, lingering finish. It has notes of black currants, blueberries and black cherries on the entry followed by baking spices – cinnamon and cardamom, liquorice, toasted oak and dried tobacco with a hint of black pepper. Pair with roasted meats, yellow cheeses and grilled vegetables.
