Aslina is a wine company owned by Ntsiki Biyela, the first black woman winemaker in South Africa. Aslina is the name of her late grandmother who was, and remains, her inspiration. Ntsiki Biyela grew up under her grandmother’s guidance and care. Aslina wines are highly limited in production. The wines are certified sustainable with minimal use of pesticides (IPW), and filtered with vegan-suitable methods.

This wine is made from 100% Sauvignon Blanc grapes that were hand picked at optimum ripeness end of February 2015. They were crushed, pressed and stabilization was done. Wine was left on the lees for 10 months to achieve a creaminess on the palate. This is a complex Sauvignon Blanc with bright fruit, lots of citrus characters, lemon zest, beautiful complexity, and depth. Only 125 cases were made.
